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Blair County Code Compliance Repair Assistance Program Guidelines

Background Information:

On ______, 2024 the County of Blair adopted Resolution____ which created the Code Compliance Repair Assistance Program within the Affordable Housing Trust Fund. The Commissioner's approved an allocation of up to \$50,000 from the Affordable Housing Trust Fund to be used to assist with code compliance/property maintenance repairs that are needed to assist low to moderate income homeowners from the magisterial code compliance process.

The Blair County Department of Social Services will be responsible for the administration of this fund through the County of Blair Affordable Housing Trust Fund Advisory Board. The Affordable Housing Trust Fund Advisory Board is composed of 5 members with staggered 2 year terms. Members consist of housing and economic developers, realtors, human service providers, financial institutions, consumers and government agencies. The Department of Social Services, along with members of the Affordable Housing Trust Fund Advisory Board, will evaluate each project request based on established criteria and develop a prioritized project list and corresponding recommendations. The Advisory Board's recommendations will be submitted to the County of Blair Board of Commissioners for final approval.

Applications will be available at the City of Altoona Codes office and the Township/Municipal offices throughout Blair County.

Code Compliance Repairs:

Repairs may include but are not limited to:

- Paint Chipping/Peeling
- Sidewalk Repair
- Handrails/Banisters repair/replacement
- Steps repair/replacement
- Shingle/Roofing Repair (excludes roof replacement)
- Rain Gutter replacement/repair
- Weeding/Lawn Maintenance

Eligible Applicants:

Eligible applicants must be the current owner occupied homeowner with low to moderate income. Landlords and tenants are not eligible. Program eligibility will utilize the Housing & Urban Development (Section 8) income guidelines.

In addition, Applicants must:

- Be current with mortgage and/or property tax payments
- Provide Income verification documentation
- Provide a list of all members living in the household and their monthly gross income
- Provide a copy of the Code Violation/Citation letter on City/Township/Municipal letterhead describing the property maintenance code violation

Available Funds:

Approximately \$50,000 is available in this funding cycle. The maximum amount for any award will not exceed \$5,000.00. A project cannot be funded 100% unless it is within the \$5,000 cap. Future funding will be based on the amount of funds available within the Affordable Housing Trust Fund.

Application:

Homeowners will be required to complete and submit a Code Compliance Repair Assistance Program Application and supporting documentation to the Blair County Department of Social Services. The application will need to include a minimum of two (2) bids from Licensed & Insured contractors for review. The selected contractor will be required to provide copies of their license and liability insurance before a Notice to Proceed will be issued.

Evaluation Criteria:

Select members of the Blair County Affordable Housing Trust Fund Advisory Board will evaluate each of the projects requested based on the evaluation criteria and develop a prioritized project list and recommendations. The recommendations will be submitted to the Blair County Board of Commissioners for final approval and award of the available funds.

Project Evaluation Criteria:

Projects will be evaluated and prioritized based on the following criteria.

- Application completeness
- Income eligibility
- Contractor Bids in relation to repairs
