Call to Order: Controller Stickel called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m.

Call for Public Comment on Prison Board Items: Controller Stickel called for public comment on Prison items. There were no comments.

Approval of Minutes from August 17, 2023 Meeting: A motion was made by Sheriff Ott and seconded by Commissioner Burke to approve the minutes from the August 17, 2023 Prison Board Meeting. The motion was unanimously carried.

**Recognition of BCP Employee**: Deputy Warden Jay Whitesel recognized Jestelynn Heaton, Corrections Counselor. She studied Criminal Justice and Political Science at Lock Haven University and was employed as a Corrections Officer at the Clinton County Correctional Facility. Her education and experience makes her a great asset to the Prison.

Controller Stickel and the Board welcomed Jestelynn.

**Inmate Population Report:** Deputy Warden Jay Whitesel provided an updated Inmate Population Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

Inmate Services Report: Deputy Warden Jay Whitesel stated: The Peerstar Re-entry Program had 5 participants. The Salvation Army presentation had 4 participants. Women's In-Prison Drug/Alcohol Pre-Release Program had 20 participants. Men's In-Prison Drug/Alcohol Pre-Release Program had 10 participants. Reformers Unanimous had 15 participants. Women's Parenting had 17 participants. Men's Parenting had 17 participants. The Good Will Re-entry Program had 8 participants. The GED Preparation Program has 11 female and 22 male participants. The Work Release Program has 6 participants. The National Alliance on Mental Illness (NAMI) had 22 female and 7 male participants.

Warden's Report: Deputy Warden Jay Whitesel provided the Warden's Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

**Staffing Update:** Lieutenant Cory Yedlosky provided a Staffing Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

COVID-19 Update: There was no update given at this time.

**Prison Sub-Committees:** Chairman Stickel stated that once the Prison Expansion Feasibility Study is presented to the Commissioners, an item would likely appear on a future Commissioners' meeting agenda.

**Financial Report**: Controller Stickel provided a report for August 2023 which will be kept on file with the minutes.

**Adjournment**: There being no further business to come before the Board, Controller Stickel adjourned the meeting at 8:45 a.m.
