#### STAFF REPORTS & SPECIAL BUSINESS

#### A. Juvenile Probation:

Requesting approval of a proposal received from Empire for the purchase and installation of three-3 new cameras for live surveillance of designated areas within the Juvenile Probation Office, in the total amount of \$4,727.00.

#### B. Controller:

- i. Requesting approval of a Contracting for Audit Services Policy.
- ii. Requesting approval to advertise via the Penn Bid website a Request for Proposal for Professional Auditing Services for the years ending December 31, 2022, 2023 and 2024 with optional three-3 year extension.

#### C. Human Resources:
