

Valley View County Park

Valley View County Park is a 45-acre park located in the City of Altoona (Pleasant Valley/Valley View Boulevard behind the Valley View Home.)

The park features picnic pavilions, charcoal grills, an amphitheater, open playing fields, a children's playground, horseshoe pits, wooded hiking trails, rest rooms, a softball-only ball diamond, an 9-hole disc golf course, a handicapped accessible garden, and parking areas.

Residents of all ages and interests enjoy the popular park, which is home to the Central Blair Recreation Commission's Summer Playground Program and Free Summer Concert Series as well as the AYSO soccer leagues.

Pavilions are available for rent for \$60.00, and may include water and electricity. When not posted as reserved, the pavilions are available for use on a first-come-first-served basis.

The Amphitheater is also available for rent for \$60.00 for more than four (4) hours and \$40.00 for less than four (4) hours.

The public is reminded to review the posted park rules, including the carry-in carryout trash policy. Park hours are 8am to Sunset from May 1st through November 30th unless otherwise posted.
