

**ORDER**

AND NOW, this 21<sup>st</sup> day of March, 2019, in keeping with this Court's previous Orders and Blair County Courthouse Security Policy, past and present, it is hereby reiterated by Order, Directive, and Decree that the Blair County Sheriff's Office has the authority to conduct reasonable searches of persons and property entering the Courthouse for the purpose of preventing any potential weapon from entering the building. The use of searches by a metal detector is authorized, as well as a pat down search of any person activating a signal from the metal detector. Administrative authority is given to the Sheriff's Office to search persons and all packages, briefcases and other containers in the immediate possession of persons entering the Courthouse property.
