Blair County will have a drive-thru only COVID-19 testing clinic at the Peoples Natural Gas Field (Blair County Ball Park-Altoona Curve Baseball Stadium) located at 1000 Park Avenue, Altoona, PA, 16602.

Clinics will be held during the following dates and times:

January 2022

Monday, January 24, 9AM-6PM

Tuesday, January 25, 9AM-6PM

Wednesday, January 26, 9AM-6PM

Thursday, January 27, 9AM-6PM

Friday, January 28, 9AM-6PM

Mid-nasal passage swab PCR tests will be performed. Testing is on a first-come, first-serve basis and is completely free. Testing is also open to individuals who are not county residents. Patients must be age three and older and are not required to show symptoms of COVID-19 in order to be tested. No appointment is necessary. Patients are encouraged to bring a photo-ID. Please follow the instructions that are provided to you at the time of testing.

Due to high numbers of people being tested on a national level, there have been delays everywhere with receiving results. Please be patient while waiting for test results. Check your email account if you provided an email address. (Make sure to check your SPAM folder.) Answer phone calls if waiting for test results.
