

NOTICE OF DUI PROGRAM INFORMATION

Due to your recent arrest for driving under the influence, and depending upon your criminal history and offense information, you have several options: ARD, Intermediate Punishment (IP), Plead guilty, and judge or jury trial. Please review the information provided and be prepared to make your request with application fee (if required) at the Preliminary Conference.

Program applications are available at the preliminary hearing or from the www.blairdap.org website

If you are a 1st time offender in the past 10 years you may want to consider the following:

<u>ARD</u>	NO JAIL
\$300 with application \$350 due at admission payable to costs and fines	Expungement
<i>Acceptance is at the discretion of the Blair County District Attorney.</i>	Limited license suspension

According to Pennsylvania law, you are **not** eligible for ARD if you:

- Had a prior DUI within the past 10 years. *Have killed or seriously injured someone as a result of a DUI crash.
- Have been charged at the time of DUI with other specific serious vehicle violations.
- Had a passenger in your vehicle under the age of 14 at the time of the offense.

COST \$ 300 due with application at Preliminary Conference, payable to Blair Drug and Alcohol Partnerships.

 \$ 350 due at admission (2 weeks following the preliminary conference), payable to Costs and Fines.

If you are not eligible or have been denied for ARD, you may want to consider the following:

<u>Intermediate Punishment (IP)</u>	LIMITED JAIL
\$300 due with application, remaining on a payment plan payable to cost and fines	Fees for Monitoring
