



Township Officials Hear Speaker From State Assoc. of Supervisors

The Blair County Association of Township Officials heard a talk by Ginni Linn, director of communications with the Pennsylvania State Association of Township Supervisors, at the fall convention of the county group Sept. 14 at the Freedom Township Fire Hall.

Ms. Linn said the PSATS is attempting to develop a grass-roots lobbying network. She urged local township officials to keep in contact with their legislators and let them know their opinions on issues affecting the townships.

She reviewed various pieces of legislation that concern township supervisors and their employees. These included turnback of roads, payments in lieu of taxes, prevailing wage rulings, bidding requirements, electronic bidding and minimum wages. She also mentioned issues of concern to tax collectors.

The guest speaker said she is looking for volunteers to serve as county liaisons with her office. She said a newsletter will soon be created by the county liaisons.

Ms. Linn encouraged all officials to attend next spring's state convention in Hershey.

Before her talk, the township officials heard a presentation by Palmer Brown of Blair Township on using Geographic Information

Systems to develop computer-based mapping that accurately shows streets, roads, tax parcels, flood plains, rivers, streams topography and other data helpful to townships for use as a planning tool.

The convention assembly also heard from a spokesman for the Federal Emergency Management Agency on hazard mitigation.

A member of the association who serves on the executive board of PSATS reported on two pieces of legislation that would change regulations governing cable providers. The new legislation, expected to pass by Sept. 30, would affect consumer standards, he said, adding that public access television channels would be affected as well.

Entertainment was by the Altoona Horseshoe Chorus, a 20-man barbershop choral group from Altoona, and the Holliday Harmonizers, a quartet.

A family-style ham and turkey dinner was served to about 120 in attendance.

David Burchfield of Duncansville RR presided. The secretary-treasurer, Glen Clapper, presented a certificate of appreciation to E. Cletus Sollenberger of Williamsburg RR 2 for serving as secretary-treasurer of the organization for 12 year. Sollenberger, 81, served as president in 1990-91.
