Call to Order: Commissioner Kessling called the meeting to order at 8:32 a.m.

Moment of Silent Reflection: Led by Commissioner Kessling

Pledge of Allegiance to the Flag: Led by Commissioner Kessling

The roll was called by Commissioner Kessling. Earnest Fuller from the Prison Society joined over phone.

Call for Public Comment on Prison Board Items: There was none.

Approval of Minutes from February 13, 2025 and March 13, 2025 Meeting: A motion was made by Commissioner Kessling and seconded by Controller Stickel to approve the minutes from the February 13, 2025 and March 13, 2025 Prison Board Meetings. The motion was unanimously carried.

Recognition of BCP Employee: Warden Tate recognized the entire staff as the Prison has passed its State compliance inspection. The Warden thanks her staff for making sure task were completed to meet inspection requirements and stepping up to help in areas outside their own to meet the inspection. Warden Tate is grateful for the maintenance staff for rearranging their schedules to get additional work done that would not be able to be completed during their regularly scheduled hours making the maintenance recommendations list much smaller after this inspections than she has preciously remembered it.

Inmate Population Report: Warden Tate provided an updated Inmate Population Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

Inmate Services Report: Deputy Warden Edmundson provided an updated Inmate Population Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

Warden's Report: Warden Tate provided the Warden's Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

Staffing Update: Warden Tate provided a Staffing Report which will be kept on file with the minutes.

Prison grass-cutting services: Warden Tate asked the Prison Board for approval to seek funds for two new weed whackers totaling three thousand dollars. The Prison Board did not approve the request at this time and recommended reaching out to these sights for equipment help or to the community.

Discussion on supervision and ongoing investigations with Human Resources were discussed.

A request for a Prison dress code was made by Commissioner Kessling. Warden Tate agreed to have it drafted by the end of the day.

Adjournment: There being no further business to come before the Board, Commissioner Kessling made the motion to adjourn and it was seconded by President Judge Kagarise. The motion passed unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 9:11 a.m.
