### **Adoption of Resolutions:**

**Resolution 405-2021**: A resolution approving the 2020 Audit Report completed by Young, Oakes, Brown and Company (YOBCO).

Resolution 406-2021: A resolution approving a Security Services Agreement between the County of Blair and Keystone Investigation and Security Specialists, LLC to provide three-3 security guards at the Fort Roberdeau Halloween Adventure, from 5:30 pm to 9:30 pm, Saturday, October 9, 2021 at the rate of \$21.00 per hour/per guard for a total of \$252.00, to be paid by the Fort Roberdeau Association.

Resolution 407-2021: A resolution approving the issuance of a Purchase Order under the Master Lease Agreement between the County of Blair and Doing Better Business for the lease of one-1 Ricoh MP2555 B/W MFP, copy, print, scan, fax machine, for District Court 24-3-02 (MDJ Dunio), in the monthly amount of \$92.00, plus \$0.0049 per excess page, for a period of sixty-60 months.
