2025 Board of Elections Minutes
Wednesday, April 16, 2025

In Attendance: Commissioner Burke, Commissioner Kessler, Commissioner Webster, County Administrator Alicia Tiracave, Director of Elections Sarah Seymour and Kay Stephens – Altoona Mirror.

Commissioner Burke called the meeting to order at 11:12 a.m.

There was no public comment.

Commissioner Burke asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the March 26, 2024 board meeting. Commissioner Kessler motioned, Commissioner Burke seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Burke asked for a motion to approve the referendum petition submitted by North Woodbury Township for the May 20, 2025 Primary:

“Do you favor the granting of malt and brewed beverage wholesale distributor's and importing distributor's licenses not for consumption on premises where sold in the Township of North Woodbury?”

313 voter signatures were required, 397 voter signatures were presented on the petition and no objections were lodged against the petitions.

Commissioner Kessler motioned, Commissioner Webster seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Commissioner Burk provided a Mail-In Ballot / Primary update:

- We have processed 5,570 mail-in applications for the May 20, 2025 Primary
- We anticipate mail-in ballots to begin mailing by the last week in April.
- The last day to register to vote or change your name/party/address is Monday, May 5th
- The last day to request a mail-in ballot is Tuesday, May 13th
