First Time Home Buyer Program (Wendy Melius)

• Wendy stated that there has been a delay in the application process through PA Housing Finance Agency (PHFA).

Weatherization/Housing Rehab Program (Trina Illig)

- Trina reported that she is meeting monthly with the weatherization program staff at Center for Community Action (CCA).
- Trina stated that two properties on the list are rental properties. Tenants can apply for the funding, but Trina feels that the landlord should be fixing the property issues.
- Going forward, rental properties will not be considered for the weatherization deferral program.

Homeless Family Shelter Update (Lisa Hann)

- Lisa reported that during the last fiscal year that the family homeless shelter served 362 individuals (108 men, 129 women & 125 children).
- Currently, 13 in house (6 men, 7 women)
- Individuals have been getting evicted from the shelter due to violations. Many individuals have maxed out their stay without finding affordable housing.

- 4 families scheduled for intake.
- Received 16 new referrals.
- 18 referrals were canceled out.
- Updating rules about lewd/mind-altering substances and Megan's Law offenders. These updated rules will help keep children safer.
- Lisa stated that there have been several success stories involving getting individuals housing.

Other Programs:

Lead Abatement Program - Trina Illig

- Funds are committed.
- Two units are currently being worked on.

Owner Occupied Rehab – Trina Illig

• Trina stated that funding is mostly committed and has been blended with other program funding, at times, to complete projects.

Whole Home (WH) Program – Trina Illig

• Trina reported that WH is up to 40 units.

TEAMeffort - Scott Durbin

• Scott reported that approximately 600 campers were in to do light construction and yard work within the City and municipalities.

Sustainable Housing Program - Missy Gillin

• No update was given on this program.

- Missy reported that many of the code compliance violations are exceeding the \$5,000 limit making the homeowner struggle to come up with the rest of the funding.
- Another issue is finding 3 contractors to bid on the project, which delays the process.
- Missy stated to continue the program that another allocation would be needed.

Scott Durbin made a motion to recommend to the commissioners to approve another allocation of funds from the AHTF in the amount of \$50,000 with a cap of \$5,000 per application/project to be administered through the Code Compliance Program. Don Delozier seconded the motion. All present were in favor. Motion carried
