Coordinator District Attorney Weeks moved to set the salary for this position at \$24.04 per hour, \$50,003.20 estimated annually. This position is Non-Union, Non-Exempt (Hourly). Full-Time at 40 hours per week. This position will be reimbursed by VOCA and RASA Grants, including payroll taxes, retirement and other benefits. This vacancy is due to the resignation of Atle Walter effective 06/25/2021. Commissioner Burke seconded the motion. The motion did not carry with a vote of 1 yes, 4 opposed.

Katherine Swigart, Director of Human Resources, stated applying the Pay Policy guidelines the candidate would qualify for \$23.35 per hour, \$48,568.00 estimated annually.

Controller Stickel moved to set the salary for the candidate at \$23.35 per hour, \$48,568.00 estimated annually. Commissioner Burke seconded the motion and it carried with a vote of 4 yes and 1 opposed (District Attorney Peter Weeks).

Commissioner Erb adjourned the meeting at 10:05 a.m.


